If you are going to provide back-up and overload communications, be sure you have enough communications equipment to do the job. It doesn't hurt to have more than what you need. You might be able to provide something that someone has forgot to bring. Just take a little time and plan on what you want to take. The time you take to prepare will be well worth it. The incident has already happened, you are going there to help smooth things out.
